Non-certificated support staff members are participants in the Public Education Employee Retirement System (PEERS) of the State of Missouri as allowed by law. A retired employee, as well as his or her dependents, surviving spouse and dependent children, shall be allowed to remain or become members in non-insurance health benefit programs, self-funded plans and insured plans by qualifying for the coverage in the manner prescribed by law under the provisions of such plan and paying the premiums of said plans.

Persons engaged by the Park Hill School District as independent contractors, including consultants, are not considered employees of the School District for purposes of membership or contribution to the Public School Retirement System or the PEERS.
